Students will need to bring into school the following equipment. This will limit any sharing,

ensure that they are ready for learning and that they have the right tools to produce work that is both

- A different coloured pen for self-assessment (green/purple)

- Glue stick

- A4 whiteboard, white board pen and rubber (sets available from Printworks)
- Water colour paint set and brush (Printworks £2.50)

In addition to this equipment students must also carry,

• a personal reading book. This is essential because it improves reading ability, quality of writing and encourages good study habits in terms of what will be expected at GCSE, A level and beyond.



A really important addition to the essential equipment list this year is an A4 mini-white board, pen and eraser for personal use in the majority of lessons. Mini—whiteboards are an excellent tool which, as a lesson progresses, allows teachers to "Check for Understanding" whilst maintaining a safe distance.
