
Key Stage 4 (Year 10, 11, 12 and 13) Essential Equipment for Effective Learning

Students will need to bring into school the following equipment. This will limit any sharing, ensure that they are ready for learning and that they have the right tools to produce work that is both organised and well presented.

- Pencil case containing the following,
- A pack of pens (black or blue)
- A range of coloured pens for self and peer assessment but also to encode notes in order to help memory and retrieval
- Pencil x 2
- Pencil sharpener
- Eraser
- 30cm ruler
- Set of colouring pencils
- Glue stick
- A4 whiteboard, whiteboard pen and rubber (available as a set from Printworks)
- Post-it notes
- Pack of highlighter pens
- A4 ring binders for storing work
- Folder dividers for organising work

In addition to equipment students must also carry,

- a personal reading book. This is essential because it improves reading ability, quality of writing and encourages good study habits in terms of what will be expected at GCSE, A level and beyond.
- Even better would be non-fiction books linked to subjects to help you "read around" your fields of study.





From a hygiene point of view we advise students to do the following,

- Carry spare hand gel.
- * Have their own drinks bottle which is clearly labelled with their name.
- * Please ensure students cover their exercise books with either sticky back plastic or a plastic exercise book cover, this makes them wipeable and will keep them looking respectable for longer.
