Dear Parent/Carer,

Congratulations once again on your child receiving a place at Wilmslow High School, you should have now received a Welcome Postcard and issues of our High Transition publication. We hope that you have found these informative and helpful in preparing your child for the move to secondary school. Transition Days

As part of our transition program we will be inviting all Year 6 students joining us in September to two transition days during the week commencing Monday 13th June. The Transition days will consist of two experiences:

Day one: (on the relevant date below according to your child's primary school) will be 'A Day in the Life'. On this day your child will attend in their primary school classes and experience a range of curriculum lessons/activities. Students should attend this day in their Primary school PE kit.

Day two: Friday 17th June, will be 'Getting to Know Your Team'. This day will consist of a range of pastoral activities led by your son or daughters new form tutor and House teams. Students will attend in their September 2022 Tutor Groups. You will receive a letter towards the end of May informing you of your child's Tutor Group and House. Students should attend this day in their Primary school PE kit.

Students should arrive at Wilmslow High School between 8:45- 9:00am through our High Options entrance. You will be responsible for your child's journey to and from Wilmslow High School. Students will need to bring a packed lunch on both days. They should also be equipped with a pen, pencil, ruler and coloured pencils in a pencil case.

Induction Evening

We would also like to welcome all parents and carers of new Year 7 students to an **Induction Evening on Tuesday 28th June**. The evening will give you the opportunity to attend a presentation before meeting your child's Head of House, Student Manager and Form Tutor. More details will follow in a further letter towards the end of May regarding this evening.


Data

It is very important that we have the correct contact information and data for your child, this includes any medical, dietary and emergency contacts. You will shortly receive a couple of emails containing

registration details for *SIMS parent*, this will allow you to register and update all contact details we hold for you and your child. It is vital that this is completed and particular attention is paid to the section on parental consent where you are required to provide consent for biometrical data use. This is required as students use thumbprint scanners for book loans in the LRC (Library) and to purchase food at our High Options canteen.

We have very much enjoyed learning about your child through our in depth conversations and visits with our feeder primary schools. We look forward to getting to know your child further over the Summer term.
