Word	Definition
Population Distribution	Is the number of people living in a given area, normally measured in people per square kilometre.
Population Density	The distribution is how the people are spread out.
Global	Relates to somewhere in the whole world
National	Relates to a country
Regional	Relates to a large area or space that might be similar.
Local	Relates to the area where you live.
HIC	High Income Country
NEE	Newly Emerging Economy
LIC	Low Income Countries
Natural	Existing in or derived from nature; not made or caused by humankind
City	An area with large numbers of people. Cities provide a very wide range of functions including universities, large hospitals and sports stadiums.
Continents	Very large areas of land
